
Centre Square Buildings



GROUND FLOOR

DESCRIPTION

With a similar plan form to Two Centre Square, one wing of the 52,365 sq ft (NIA) building closes the vista across Centre Square from Albert Road and consequently is highly visible from one of the main north-south routes through the town. The 'L' shape encloses two sides of the new civic square. Overlooking Centre Square, the west wing is five storeys tall while the adjacent wing is four storeys. The latter also enjoys views across the new square, while the top floors have a panoramic view to the south and the Hambleton Hills. A combination of curtain wall and iridescent cladding panels sit within a strong white brick frame.
